

The György Klapka Elementary School – Isaszeg

The György Klapka Elementary School was founded in Isaszeg in 1963. The founders chose his name, as György Klapka was the successful general during the Spring Campaign winning the Battle of Isaszeg on 6 April 1849 against the Austrian Army.

Currently, we have 550 students and 39 teachers in our school. Besides the general lessons, the teachers provide several types of extra programs to the students, such as football, athletics, PE, IT and choir. Further studies can be done in the afternoon sessions. During summer holidays we organize camps to Zamárdi, Zobákpusztá and Kiseccset. During the school year those who learn German as a foreign language can travel to Austria, Germany or Switzerland. Our students also traveled three times to England and twice to Poland and Italy.

In our school there are classes with special music education and the children from these classes perform in the school and local and national events. The Károly Kós Arts School, a special department of our school, provides the students with art and pottery classes. Moreover, they can learn to play musical instruments.

We find it very important to encourage our students to achieve their best and always think about school, where they spend their first 8 years in education, with fondness.
